



Scotiabank Calgary Marathon, Sunday, May 27, 2012

- Voted the 2010 & 2009 Best Road Race in Alberta by participants, The Scotiabank Calgary Marathon is a challenging, competitive and fun event with a race designed for everyone at any level.
- The Scotiabank Calgary Marathon is Canada's oldest marathon and will celebrate 50 years in 2014.
- There is a full-marathon, half-marathon, 10k, 5k walk and run and kids' marathon.
- In 2012, we expect over 11,000 runners and walkers and \$600,000 is expected to be raised for 40 official charities.
- In 2011, we had close to 9,800 participants and just over half a million dollars was raised for 30 charities through the Scotiabank Group Charity Challenge.
- The Scotiabank Calgary Marathon is more than a race. It is a family-oriented community event that celebrates sportsmanship, healthy lifestyles and community participation.
- The Scotiabank Calgary Marathon course is certified by AIMS (Association of International Marathon Society) and by Athletics Alberta and is a qualifier for the Boston Marathon.
- Scotiabank is sponsoring seven (7) cash prizes, for the charities that raise the most money, raise the most money per runner, have the most runners participating (with a minimum of \$10 raised per runner) and for the charity of the top individual fundraiser. Charities are only eligible to win one of the seven prizes.
- Communities along the route can raise money for charity through the Neighbourhood Spirit Challenge.
