



Scotiabank Calgary Marathon May 30, 2010 Fact Sheet

Where: All race-day activities will be starting and finishing in Bridgeland at Murdoch Park, located at Centre Avenue and 9th street N.E. The course will pass through the zoo and the Stampede Grounds, meander down 17th Avenue visiting some beautiful neighborhoods and parks on route to Memorial Drive. Participants will enjoy a stunning view at the University, around Varsity and back down Memorial Drive before arriving at the Bridgeland finish line.

When: Event day is Sunday May 30, 2010. The Scotiabank Marathon starts at 7 am; the 10k and 4 x 10k starts at 7:30 am; the 5k starts at 9 am and the Timbits Marathon starts at 10 am.

Who: More than 9,000 competitors are expected to participate in the Scotiabank Calgary Marathon.
